For new registrations, proof of residency is required. Proof of residence documents must include the voter's name and current residential address. If their Wisconsin ID card matches their address there will be no additional documentation. If the Wisconsin ID address doesn't match, they can use any of the following:

- bank statement
- credit card statement
- residential lease
- a check or other document issued by a unit of government
- an intake document from a residential care facility such as a nursing home or assisted living facility.

For anyone without an ID card that matches their new address, you can email us the documentation prior to our meeting date and we can finalize their registration.

Additionally, we are always able to register any residents day of as long as they bring their Wisconsin photo ID and any of the above listed documents.

Anyone without a Wisconsin ID can utilize the DMV in Fort Atkinson on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month to obtain an ID for voting purposes.
